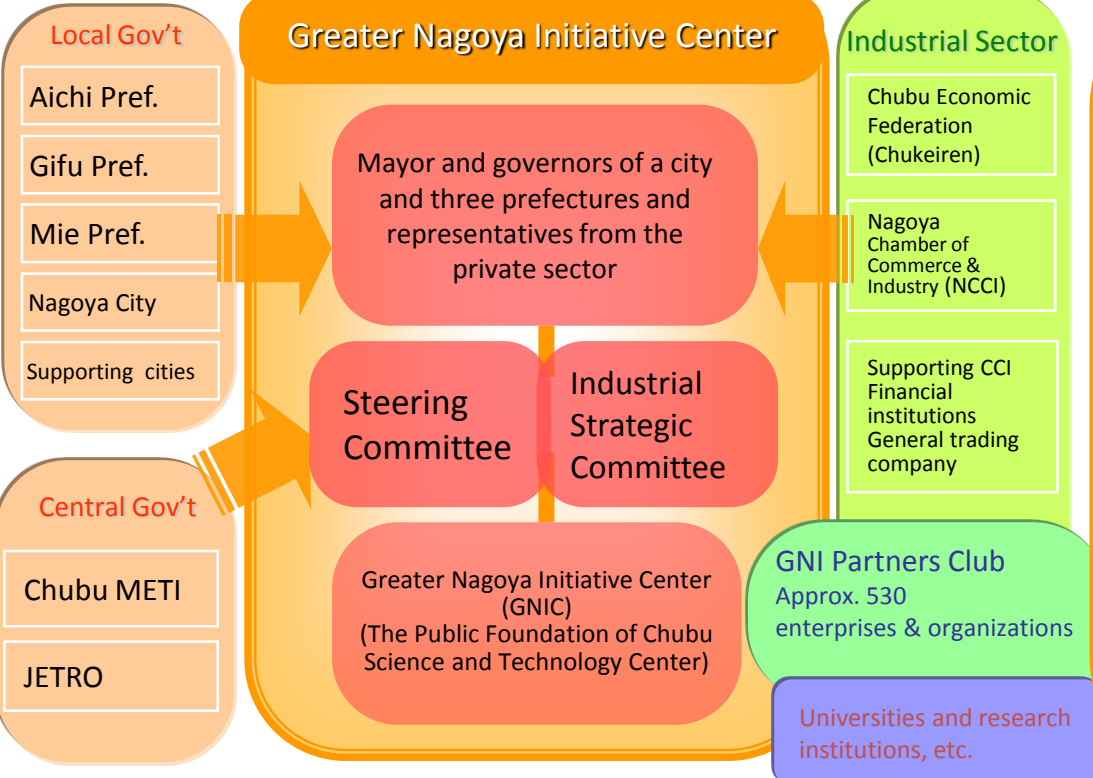


Greater Nagoya Initiative (GNI)

*Companies start building their relationship for business issues since then.

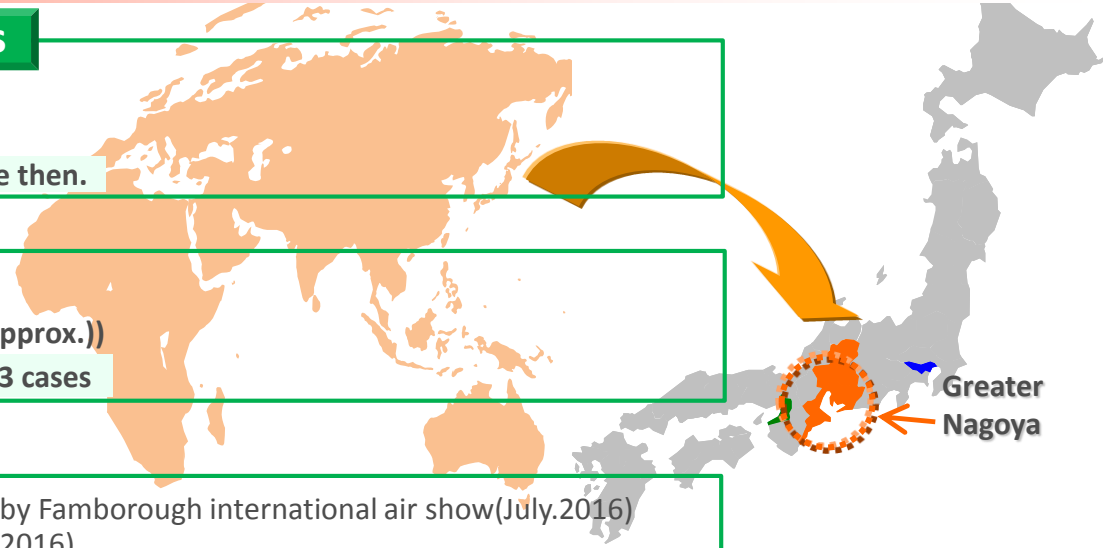
Delegation: 61 overseas missions
